DRAFT ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 5 OF DIVISION 24 OF THE LOS ANGELES ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REGARDING OFFICEHOLDER CONTROLLED FUNDS REGULATIONS

Honorable Members:

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, that repeals officeholder controlled fund provisions of the Ethics Commission's regulations.

Summary of Ordinance

The draft ordinance repeals the title and Section 24.51 of Chapter 5 of Division 24 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code which include Ethics Commission regulations for officeholder controlled funds.

In March, 2015, changes to City's Municipal Code relating to officeholder and legal defense committees became effective. The Municipal Code changes incorporated and clarified disclosure requirements for officeholder and legal defense committees. The Administrative Code provisions are now redundant and no longer accurate.

As Chapter 5 of Division 24 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code are regulations of the Ethics Commission, the Ethics Commission has the authority to repeal the regulations subject to approval or disapproval of the City Council and Mayor

pursuant to Charter Section 703(b). The Ethics Commission approved repeal of the title and Section at its meeting held on April 21, 2015.

Pursuant to Charter Section 703(b), the City Council is required to conduct a hearing and either approve or disapprove the regulatory action within 60 days of the Ethics Commission's action.
