ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to options for implementing five enhanced watershed management programs (EWMPs).

Recommendation for Council action:

NOTE and FILE the June 1, 2018 Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) report relative to options for implementing five EWMPs.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Not applicable.

<u>Community Impact Statement</u>: None submitted.

Summary:

On June 5, 2018, your Committee considered a June 1, 2018 BOS report relative to options for implementing five EWMPs. According to the BOS, the report is in response to Council's November 1, 2017 action in connection with funding options for the implementation of five Enhanced Watershed Management Programs for the Upper Los Angeles River, Santa Monica Bay, Ballona Creek, Marina del Rey, and Dominguez Channel watersheds. The BOS developed these EWMPs as compliance documents for meeting the waterquality requirements of the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit andthe Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) regulations.

On June 19, 2015, Council authorized the BOS to submit the draft EWMPs to the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), and to revise the documents upon receiving comments. The final EWMPs were submitted in January 2016, and approved by the RWQCB in April 2016. After further consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committed moved to note and file the June 1, 2018 BOS report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
