SUMMARY

At its meeting of June 1, 2015, the Budget and Finance Committee considered a Finance report relative to a request by the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to escheat monies from the UMSIATF to the General Fund. Finance reports that it has reviewed escheatment eligibility and publication notices per Council's instructions. The Finance report, attached to the Council file, includes a copy of LAPD's request and the proof of publication advertisements from the Office of the City Clerk. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Budget and Finance Committee recommended approval of the escheatment amount of \$1,433,758,29. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
