Dear Council Members,

Please support Mobility Plan 2035 with ALL of the modal networks intact. Just like our roads for cars, we need complete, convenient, direct networks for people who walk, cycle and use public transit. Please do not allow this carefully designed plan to be picked apart.

Creating a safe, inviting environment on our roads for people who walk, bike and use transit is not about “forcing” people to use these modes of travel. The vision behind the new Mobility Plan is about giving people the choice to opt out of driving if they want to, and opt out of automobile congestion as well. And regarding emergency response times, we need to realize that the occasions where first responders may, in some cases, be delayed by redesigned roadways are rare events by their nature. On the other hand, the safety, mobility and humanizing features created by redesigning our roads to serve the needs of a variety of users will bring tangible benefits to the community 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
