Please distribute this letter to the members of the Transportation Committee before they meet to hear testimony on the Mobility Element Plan 2035.

At our July 09, 2015 meeting a motion was submitted to the members of our Board concerning ENV. 2013-0911-EIR. The motion was moved, seconded, and carried, that a letter be written to the members of the Transportation Committee stating that since the Mobility Element contains little to no analysis detailing how the different “enhanced Networks” will interact with each other that it needs to be sent back to the Planning Department for further study and then recirculated to the public. It is simply not acceptable for the City of Los Angeles (As stated in the Statement of Overriding Considerations) to produce a system that will increase congestion, negatively impact Emergency response times as well as negatively impacting endangered species and habitats.
