Attached is the Grant Acceptance Packet for the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG), Drug Enforcement, Education and Prevention (DEEP) Program sub-award in the amount of \$105,598 received by the City Attorney's Office. JAG funds were allocated to the California Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC), who in turn awarded Los Angeles County a grant in the amount of \$1,248,146 to establish the Drug Enforcement, Education and Prevention (DEEP) Program to combat mid to high level narcotics trafficking in Los Angeles County. The sub-recipient award to the City will allow the City Attorney's Office to fund a new prosecutor (Deputy City Attorney I) to abate locations with chronic gang and narcotic activities. As a participant in the Grants Pilot Program, this department submitted the packet for review and analysis by the CAO Grants Oversight Unit and the appropriate CAO Analyst.

In accordance with the approved procedures for the Pilot, this Office reviewed the Packet for completeness, conducted a concise analysis and prepared a Fiscal Impact Statement. The Grant Acceptance Packet consists of the following:
