ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a proposed contract with Golden Bell Products, Inc. for roach control and treatment services for the City's Wastewater Conveyance System.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), to execute the proposed contract with Golden Bell Products, Inc. for roach control and treatment services for the City's Wastewater Conveyance System for a term of five years at a cost not to exceed \$995,000.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer (CAO) reports that there is no General Fund impact as the 2018-19 Adopted Budget provides \$150,000 in the Sanitation Expense and Equipment Account, a special purpose fund appropriation within the Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund, to support the first year cost of this contract. Subsequent year funding will be provided through the City's annual budget development process, which is subject to Mayor and Council approval. Consistent with the City's Financial Policies, the contracts include a Financial Liability Clause which limits the City's annual financial obligation to the amount of funding provided in the corresponding year's annual budget.
