RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

 - A. APPROVE the attached Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for payment to IBM Corporation (IBM) for professional services to migrate the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) data from its existing COPLINK Node to the Regional Terrorism Information and Integration System (RTIIS) Node; and,
 - B. AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to execute the attached MOA, on behalf of the City, with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD).
- 3. That the Board TRANSMIT the report concurrently to the Mayor and the City Council for their approval.

DISCUSSION

The LAPD will join the LASD's RTIIS Node by decommissioning its existing COPLINK Node. The migration of the LAPD's COPLINK data to the RTIIS Node will be facilitated by IBM.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

In furtherance of the above objective, the LAPD will transfer funds to LASD, who will make payment to IBM for the migration of COPLINK data.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT,

AND THE

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT REGARDING PAYMENT TO IBM CORPORATION

FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AND HOSTING LAPD COPLINK DATA

RECITALS

Whereas the Los Angeles Police Department will join the Regional Terrorism Information and Integration System (RTIIS) Node; and

Whereas the Los Angeles Police Department will decommission its existing COPLINK Node upon successful completion of the migration to the RTIIS Node; and

Whereas the Los Angeles Police Department will provide funding for the migration services that IBM will perform to migrate the Los Angeles Police Department data from its existing COPLINK Node to the RTIIS Node.

I. PARTIES AND PURPOSE

- A. The parties to this Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") are the Los Angeles Police Department (hereafter "LAPD") and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (hereafter "LASD").
- B. The purpose of this MOA is for the transfer of funds for the billing costs related to the payment to IBM Corporation (hereafter "IBM") for professional services to migrate the LAPD data from its existing COPLINK Node to the RTIIS Node.
- C. The purpose of this MOA is for the transfer of funds for costs associated with hardware and software licenses required for hosting the LAPD COPLINK data.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LOS ANGELES SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

In furtherance of the above objective, the LASD hereby agree to the following:

- A. Receive and pay IBM's invoice for migration services; and,
- B. Send a copy of the invoice for the annual bill to the following address:

C. Should the LASD incur any penalties for failure to pay the annual bill in a timely manner, the City will not be responsible for any portion of the penalties incurred.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT

In furtherance of the above objective, the LAPD herby agrees to the following:

- A. Review the LASD invoice; and,
- B. Reimburse the LASD for costs incurred for migrating the LAPD data to the RTIIS COPLINK Node; and,
- C. Submit the reimbursement via check to the LASD at the following address:

IV. TERM OF AGREEMENT
