The City of Los Angeles is very concerned if a new request to sell alcohol is subject to one of the conditions below. There is a strong likelihood that the City will deny your "public convenience or necessity" application if one of the above listed conditions apply to your site. (It is strongly suggested that you contact your Council Office and discuss your project. If the Council Office does not oppose your

1. The proposed site is in an area with a long-term level of undue concentration of alcoholic beverage outlets.

The Project Site is located within Census Tract 1396.00 for which, according to the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control ("ABC") licensing criteria, four on-sale and three off-sale alcoholic beverage licenses are allocated. Per ABC's Licensing Department, (Van Nuys, CA Office) there are 21 existing on-site and 4 existing off-site alcoholic beverage licenses within the subject Census Tract, including one alcoholic beverage license granted to Gyoro Gyoro Izakaya Japonasise at the Project Site (17401 W. Ventura Boulevard; Unit B21).

The subject location is within the highly developed Ventura Boulevard commercial corridor, which contains a variety of restaurants and entertainment venues, and has resulted in the number of existing on-site alcohol licenses exceeding the maximum allocated. Although the subject census tract is numerically over-concentrated, the project will not adversely affect community welfare because the proposed sale of alcoholic beverages in a recreational art studio will enhance the subject art studio use, which is a desirable use in an area designated for such. Within the urban context of this Ventura Boulevard commercial district, the proposed sale of alcoholic beverages within a recreational art studio will be consistent with the character of other development in the area. Thus, it can be reasonably assured that the welfare of the community will not be adversely impacted.

The geographic area is the target of special law enforcement activity, i.e., police task force is working on reducing vice in the area, or eliminating juvenile crime (such as cruising or graffiti) or gang activity.

We are unaware of any applicable targeted law enforcement activity in the area.

3. The proposed site is in close proximity to sensitive uses, including schools, parks, churches, youth activities, homeless shelters, mental health or alcohol or drug treatment centers.

The following sensitive uses are located within 600 feet of the proposed site:

The following sensitive uses are within 600 to 1,000 feet of the site: •Single Family Residences (200 feet to the north, across the parking lot) •Mission: Renaissance Encino – 17401 Ventura Blvd. •Asthma & Allergy Care Center – 17203 Ventura Blvd. •Hazel Caregivers, a Medical Marijuana Dispensary – 17523 Ventura Blvd.

 The geographic area has elevated levels of alcohol-related crimes, including but not limited to: public intoxication, driving under the influence, assault, vandalism, prostitution, drug violations, and/or loitering.

In the Determination Letter issued by the Los Angeles Department of City Planning's Zoning Administrator on June 12, 2015 for Pinot's Palette of Encino, the Zoning Administrator addresses alcohol-related crime concerns in the following statements:

"Although the subject census tract is numerically over-concentrated, the project will not adversely affect community welfare because the proposed sale of alcoholic beverages in a recreational art studio will enhance the subject art studio use, which is a desirable use in an area designated for such. Within the urban context of this Ventura Boulevard commercial district, the proposed sale of alcoholic beverages within a recreational art studio will be consistent with the character of other development in the area. Thus, it can be reasonably assured that the welfare of the community will not be adversely impacted."

"According to statistics provided by the Los Angeles Police Department, which has jurisdiction over the subject property, within Crime Reporting District No. 1067, a total of 119 crimes were reported in 2014, compared to the citywide average of 163 crimes and the high crime reporting district average of 196 crimes for the same period. In 2014, there were 8 Narcotics, 1 Liquor Law, and 0 Public Drunkenness, 1 Disturbing the Peace, 1 Disorderly Conduct, and 13 DWI related arrests." As shown in these statements and statistics, and by granting approval of the Conditional Use, the Zoning Administrator did not find elevated levels of alcohol related crimes.

5. The proposed site is located in a Specific Plan or Community Redevelopment Agency Project area that specifically includes a policy to control future alcoholic beverage sales.

The subject property is located within the adopted Encino-Tarzana Community Plan area, and within the adopted Ventura/Cahuenga Boulevard Corridor Specific Plan area. Neither the Community Plan nor the Specific Plan includes a policy to control future alcoholic beverage sales. The subject property is not located within a Community Redevelopment Project area.

- d. Result in an aesthetic upgrade to the neighborhood (in what exact way) <u>Pinot's Palette of Encino</u> has occupied a formerly vacant storefront, enlivening the shopping center with a clean and attractive use, and adding to the current mix of retail, entertainment and recreation options available within the community. By enhancing and diversifying the shopping experience, the addition of the proposed project will attract a wider customer base, and increase foot traffic, thereby contributing to the overall vitality of the community.
- e. Contribute to the long-term economic development (how) <u>Pinot's Palette of Encino has occupied</u> a formerly vacant storefront, adding to the current mix of retail, entertainment and recreation options available within the community, consistent with the current trend of providing a mix of restaurant and entertainment choices within shopping centers, targeting an enhanced and more diversified shopping experience, a wider customer base, and increased foot traffic, thereby contributing to the overall economic vitality of the shopping center. Area restaurants will directly benefit from this business, since Pinot's Palette of Encino does not provide food. As a recreational art studio within the commercial shopping enter, Pinot's Palette of Encino will provide a regionally-serving amenity for residents and visitors within the San Fernando Valley and greater Los Angeles area, as well as to the local surrounding community, city, and region.
- f. Provide a beneficial cultural/entertainment outlet (specify) Pinot's Palette of Encino is a venue for artistic expression, and allows patrons to participate in an entertaining cultural activity by providing them with all of the tools and guidance they may need to have a fulfilling painting

experience.

In particular, it is a recreational art studio that provides patrons with a unique, and complete, painting experience by offering them a canvas to paint, all the art supplies needed, (optional) step-by-step instruction from a professional instructor, and the option of painting during open studio days, regular classes, or at privately booked parties, along with incidental beer and wine service.
 - c. Other non-alcohol sales business options available so alcohol does not have to be sold, e.g., more specialty products, broader range of items like fresh meats or fruits and vegetables, etc. <u>No / Not Applicable A kitchen is not included as part of Pinot's Palette as it is operationally superfluous. Due to the 2-3 hour length of the classes / painting sessions, most patrons do not remain at the facility long enough to consume food, although snacks and alternative beverages (e.g., soda and water) are available.</u>
