

**MOTION**

In recent weeks, several small wooden structures affixed with wheels, approximately the size of a garden shed, have been placed on public streets in San Pedro, and other communities across the City, and are being used as temporary shelters for the homeless.

These structures are unpermitted, and have no running water, no sewer connection, and no reflective markings to make them visible to drivers, posing a great risk to public health and safety.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Attorney, with the assistance of any other department as necessary, be REQUESTED to report on the legality of the placement of such structures in both the public right-of-way and on private property, and recommend removal protocol for City departments to follow.
