Brief Summary: The ERNC recommends that Los Angeles City Charter Section 22.805 be amended, to require that all nominees for the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners (BONC) be required to have either (1) served on any City of Los Angeles Neighborhood Council for at least one year, or (2) have attended at least five Neighborhood Council meetings, before their appointment can be considered by the City Council.

To the Mayor, the City Council, and the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners,
