TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to prohibit the parking of vehicles for private sale on both sides of Sherman Way between Winnetka and Corbin Avenues.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson):

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to amend LAMC Section 87.55, which establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles for private sale on certain City streets or public lands, to prohibit the parking of such vehicles on both sides of Sherman Way between Winnetka and Corbin Avenues.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer or the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On October 14, 2015, your Committee considered a Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson) relative to amending LAMC Section 87.55, which establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles for private sale on certain City streets or public lands, to prohibit the parking of such vehicles on both sides of Sherman Way between Winnetka and Corbin Avenues. According to the Motion, on April 5, 2011, Council approved the addition of Section 87.55 to Chapter VIII of the LAMC that establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles displaying a "For Sale" sign or placard advertising the private sale of that vehicle. After conducting a public hearing, Section 87.55 allows the City Council to amend this Section to include additional streets or public lands. A large number of vehicles are consistently parked on both sides of Sherman Way between Winnetka and Corbin Avenues for the sole purpose of displaying them for private sale. This situation is monopolizing on-street parking and creating visual blight in these communities.

After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the Motion as detailed in the above recommendation. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
