PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council note and file the report, as it is for informational purposes only.

SUMMARY

On September 13, 2019, the City Council approved an Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles 2024 Exploratory Committee, and the United States Olympic Committee (collectively, the Parties) regarding the Los Angeles 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The Amendment to the MOU extends the date for entering into the Los Angeles 2028 Games Agreement (Games Agreement) and the associated Youth Sports Program Partnership (YSP) Agreement from September 14, 2019 to March 14, 2020. The Council also requested the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), and the City Attorney to submit a report to Council in four weeks with an update regarding the status of the YSP Agreement. This report is provided pursuant to the aforementioned Council instruction.

The Parties have been cooperating in good faith to negotiate and obtain the approvals necessary to enter into a Games Agreement and associated YSP Agreement. In the interest of establishing a youth sports program and executing the YSP Agreement at the earliest date possible, the Parties are prioritizing the negotiations and review of issues pertaining to the YSP Agreement. General terms of the YSP Agreement have been reached between the Parties; however, negotiations are continuing regarding details of the agreement. The CAO, CLA, RAP, and City Attorney will submit a report to Council regarding the YSP Agreement when negotiations are complete.
