**MOTION**

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations of the City Attorney in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Joyce Miller (Zsibrita), et al. v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court, Lead Case Nos. BC316318 and BC356529 (this matter arises from an incident involving members of the Los Angeles Police Department), **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to expend up to \$890,600 in settlement of the above-entitled matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the Controller to transfer \$890,600 from the Liability Claims Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts, to Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw demands from Fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009792, Police Liability Payouts as follows:
  - a. Up to \$285,600 made payable to CPT Group, Inc.
  - b. Up to \$605,000 made payable to Johnson and Johnson, LLP.
4. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer; and, AUTHORIZE the Controller to implement the instructions.

This matter was recommended for approval by the Budget and Finance Committee (Krekorian – Englander – Koretz: “Yes”) at its meeting on August 7, 2017, in Closed Session as permitted by Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1).
