Honorable Members:

This Office recommends that discussions with, and advice from, legal counsel regarding the status of this pending litigation be scheduled and held in closed session pursuant to California Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(1). Government Code Section 54956.9 requires you to state publicly, prior to the closed session, what subdivision of that section authorizes the closed meeting and that the closed session is being held to confer or discuss with, or receive advice from, legal counsel regarding pending litigation against the City.

The pending litigation consists of three cases, which have been related and consolidated, alleging that Proposition 26, codified at Article XIII C, Section 1(e) of the California Constitution, forbids the Department of Water and Power's annual transfer of money from the Power Revenue Fund to (ultimately) the City's General Fund.
