On October 12, 2018, this Office transmitted a draft ordinance amending the City's campaign finance ordinance (City Attorney Report No. R18-0313).

On December 11, 2018, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered this matter and recommended changing the aggregate fundraising threshold for City Council candidates to qualify for matching funds from \$25,000 to \$20,000. The enclosed revised draft ordinance incorporates that change.
