

One Coordinated Response



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- PREVENTIVE STRATEGIES to stop the influx of homeless individuals due to economic and housing pressures as well as gaps in the foster care, health, mental health and prison systems
- CENTRALIZED CASE MANAGEMENT to navigate homeless individuals to the resources and housing they need in a caring, supportive and persistent way
- HOUSING to provide short and long-term solutions unique to the needs of the homeless individual or family
- ON-GOING SUPPORT to ensure permanent housing and economic sustainability

Build vs. Lease Over 10 Years





Illustration of Annual Unit Production for 10 Year Housing Program
