

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY, and BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEES' REPORTS relative to recreational vehicle (RV) waste pumping.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson - Englander) and SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Bureau of Sanitation (LABOS) to establish a voucher program with the four private RV disposal stations identified in this report.
2. INSTRUCT the LABOS, from the Sewer Construction and Maintenance Fund (SCMF), to identify funding of \$26,000 annually from the General Fund for the voucher program as identified in the LABOS report dated June 29, 2018, attached to the Council file; the SCMF will carry the cost for late reimbursement for the General Fund or from end of year surplus General Fund.
3. INSTRUCT the LABOS to identify funding of \$150,000 from the General Fund for construction costs for two permanent City RV disposal stations to be located at the two LABOS maintenance yards in the San Fernando Valley; and, AUTHORIZE the LABOS to identify funding of \$50,000 for two Maintenance Laborers.
4. INSTRUCT the LABOS, in coordination with the City Administrative Officer (CAO), the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), and the Controller's Office, to make the necessary financial and technical adjustments to implement these recommendations.
5. INSTRUCT the LABOS to continue searching Citywide for one or two additional sites, to be used as City RV disposal stations.


Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the LABOS. Neither the CAO nor CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on August 1, 2018, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - Harris-Dawson - Englander) and a report from LABOS regarding RV waste pumping. Staff from LABOS provided the Committee information regarding various sites, cost associated and a recommendation to expand to other sites. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendations in the LABOS report, with the additional amendment to search for one or two additional sites. This matter is now submitted to Council for consideration.
