Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bonin - O'Farrell):

- 1. REQUEST the Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) to do the following:
 - a. Immediately begin preparing and submitting monthly reports on the status of implementation of safe parking in Los Angeles, including the number of operational lots, the success rate of local service providers in recruiting clients for the lots, the number of people currently being served, and the number of people successfully housed.
 - b. Prepare a report on obstacles to successful, optimal operation of safe parking programs, with recommendations for corrective action.
- REQUEST LAHSA to report on resources needed to give the ability for LAHSA to be able
 to act quickly in bringing people into the Coordinated Entry System and report on number of
 people enrolled in the safe parking programs, number of people entered into Coordinated
 Entry System through the program, and number of housing placements.
- REQUEST LAHSA to report on their internal procedure on Request for Proposals (RFP) and procedures for formulating the RFP process, how evaluators of the RFP are chosen, and the criteria for RFP scoring.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
