I MOVE that the matter of the Homelessness and Poverty Committee Report relative to the City's Comprehensive Homeless Strategy, Item No. 6 on today's Council agenda (CF#15-1138-S1), BE AMENDED to:

- 1. Add to Strategy 3A No Wrong Door/Standardize First Responder Training for Homeless the following underlined language:
  - "...such as experience with trauma including domestic violence."
- 2. Revise <u>Strategy 3B Develop Encampment Engagement Protocol</u> to replace "...homeless victims who have been victims of domestic violence" with "...homeless individuals who have been victims of trauma, including domestic violence."
- 3. Revise Strategy 9K Women's Homelessness & Domestic Violence as follows:
  - Delete the instruction relative to employment development for homeless women and incorporate that instruction into a new <u>Strategy 9L - Women's</u> <u>Homelessness - Employment Development</u> which is adopted hereby; and
  - Revise the Performance Metrics as set forth below:
    - Additional <del>Domestic Violence</del> beds/units <u>set aside for women</u> experiencing homeless, including survivors of domestic violence, sexual abuse and/or sex trafficking;
    - Statistics pertaining to women experiencing homelessness, including housing needs of survivors of domestic violence, sexual abuse, and/or sex trafficking related homelessness, including victim housing needs.;
    - Employment services and job placements provided to homeless women and domestic violence victims; and
    - Research on evidence-based housing solutions for women, including survivors of domestic violence.
