<u>State source</u>: Part I crime information from the *2014 Crime in California* by the Attorney General, California Department of Justice was used to calculate a State crime rate. Part I Violent Crime includes homicide, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. Part I Property Crime includes burglary, motor vehicle theft, total larceny –theft and arson.

<u>Local source</u>: Website: <u>https://data.lacity.org</u>. Los Angeles Open Data Portal, that includes information from the Los Angeles Police Department. Part I crime data used to calculate a local crime rate includes statistics from January 1, 2015 through December 2, 2015 (available as of January 2016). Part I Violent crime includes homicide, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. Part I Property Crimes include burglary, motor vehicle theft (GTA), larceny (BFTV/TFMV, grand theft person and other theft) and arson.

<u>Note</u>: AB 2 does not specify a type of crime, either violent or property crimes, required to calculate the crime rate. The crime rates used to create the maps, are based on the sum of Part I - Violent Crime and Part I - Property Crime, as listed above.
