An ordinance amending Section 103.205 of Division 8, Article 3 of Chapter X of the Los Angeles Municipal Code regulating the issuance of police permits to Massage Businesses.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. Subdivision 2 of Subsection (b) of Section 103.205 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

2. **Additional Requirements.** In addition to those requirements specified in Chapter X, Article 3, Division 3 of this Code, each applicant for a Massage Establishment or Out-Call Massage Business permit shall furnish the following information to the Board: all convictions for any crime involving conduct which requires registration under California Penal Code Section 290, or of conduct which is a violation of California Penal Code Sections 266i, 314, 315, 316, 318, 647(a), 647(b), or any crime involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or moral turpitude.


Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


