## DRAFT ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 103.205 OF THE LOS ANGELES MUNICIPAL CODE REGULATING THE ISSUANCE OF POLICE PERMITS TO MASSAGE BUSINESSES

Honorable Members:

Pursuant to the request of this Honorable Body, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. This draft ordinance would amend Section 103.205 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) related to the issuance of police permits to Massage Businesses. The draft ordinance would: (1) eliminate the additional application requirements for Massage Establishments or Out-Call Massage Businesses provided for in LAMC Section 103.205(b)2, except for subparagraph (x) that requires applicants to furnish information to the Board of Police Commissioners concerning convictions of certain types of enumerated crimes; (2) add Penal Code Section 314 to LAMC Section 103.205(f); and (3) eliminate certain Massage Establishment building and facility requirements provided for in LAMC Section 103.205(d)(6).
