PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to reducing response times for emergency medical service calls and rescues on or in the water that are currently fielded by Fireboat 2 housed at the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) Station 112 located in San Pedro.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Buscaino - Blumenfield):

- INSTRUCT the LAFD to report with recommendations on how to reduce response times for emergency medical service calls and rescues on or in the water that are currently fielded by Fireboat 2.
- 2. INSTRUCT the LAFD to report in 60 days relative to options for permanently assigning a fast response boat to LAFD Station 112.
