COUNCIL TRANSMITTAL: REQUEST FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT AND EXECUTE \$472,000 TRAFFIC SAFETY GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Housing + Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) is requesting authority to accept the \$472,000 grant from the State Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) to continue to provide the child passenger safety program from October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016. The program consists of traffic-safety education, training, and free car and booster seats to eligible low-income residents citywide. Grant funds will be used for City personnel implementing program services, the procurement of car seats, administration expenses, travel, and program supplies. This grant is a continuation of the State OTS grant the City received for October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015 (C.F.10-0065). The Office of Traffic Safety requires that grant recipients apply for funding each year to continue delivering services.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The General Manager of the Los Angeles Housing + Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) respectfully requests that:

- I. Your office schedule this transmittal at the next available meeting(s) of the appropriate City Council committee(s) and forward it to City Council for review and approval immediately after;
- II. That the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, take the following actions:

- 1. AUTHORIZE HCIDLA to accept and execute a \$472,000 grant agreement with the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for the "Child Passenger Safety Program" for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016, subject to approval of the City Attorney as to form.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the City Controller to adjust appropriation amounts within Fund 45C as follows:
 - a. Increase appropriations in the amount of \$472,000 within the Office of Traffic Safety Grant Fund No. 45C as follows:

- d. Expend funds upon proper demand of the General Manager of HCIDLA, or designee.
- AUTHORIZE the General Manager of HCIDLA, or designee, to prepare Controller instructions for technical corrections that may be necessary and consistent with the Mayor and Council action on this matter, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the City Controller to implement such transactions.

BACKGROUND

Over the last ten years the City has received the State Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) grant to provide child passenger safety education classes and free car and booster seats to low income residents of Los Angeles. The program is carried out by City employees with the Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) who are certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians. They educate parents on the proper selection, use, and

installation of car and booster seats, measure children for booster seats, and provide free car and booster seats to eligible low-income parents and caregivers. The HCIDLA's child passenger safety team works through the City's Family Source Centers (FSCs) and other non-profit health and welfare agencies to present two hour educational classes. Additional activities of this program include participation in community events and health fairs.

The grant for Federal Funding Year (FFY) 2014-2015, which ended September 30, 2015, was \$450,000. At the end of the grant term, HCIDLA staff had conducted over 200 car seat safety education classes for 3,600 people, participated in fourteen community events citywide that were attended by 8,400 residents, and distributed 3,485 free car and booster seats to low-income program participants. Additionally, HCIDLA staff evaluated and corrected the installation of car seats through safety check-up events and conducted two surveys of cars and vans traversing city streets to determine if children were secured in safety seats. Each of these activities met or exceeded program goals, except the distribution of car seats which was short by 15 seats due to the cancellation of a class during the last week of service.

REQUEST TO ACCEPT STATE GRANT

On December 1, 2014, the OTS announced increased traffic-safety grant opportunities for FFY 2015-2016 to be awarded on a competitive basis to state and local jurisdictions. The HCIDLA submitted a proposal for \$1,018.050.00 to increase current services and expand the program to include bicycle & pedestrian safety; however a tentative notification was sent on June 1, 2015 that it had only been awarded a grant in the amount of \$472,000 to fund the "Child Passenger Safety Program" (Attachment 1).

HCIDLA is requesting authority to accept the \$472,000 grant from the State Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) to provide a child passenger safety program for FFY October 1, 2015 – September 30, 2016. Although there was a slight increase in the grant funding the adjustment cost for staff, materials and fees, have resulted in reduction of child safety seats from 3,000.

BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS

HCIDLA is requesting authority to appropriate funds totaling \$413,239 to pay for costs for the period October 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 (\$195,950 direct costs, \$60,314 fringe benefits and \$156,975 car scats, storage and certification fees). Due to the overlap of grant program year (October to September) and the City fiscal year (July to June), the balance of \$58,761 (\$472,000 less \$413,239) is available for salaries and fringes for the first quarter of FY 16-17.

Expenditures for the period July 1, 2015 to September 30, 2015 will be paid from the prior year Grant No. OP1503 (October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015). The remaining balance of the grant totaling \$72,593.82 (\$42,869.11 direct and \$29,724.71 fringe benefits) for July 2015 to September 2015 is appropriated in the FY 2015-2016 budget and in CF 14-0065 which approved the acceptance of the prior year OTS grant.

To reconcile the available grant sources to appropriations, HCIDLA is requesting authority to reduce appropriations totaling \$85,671.71. The amount represents over-appropriations for prior Grant No. OP1405 (\$13,077.89) and Grant No. OP1503 (\$72,593.82). Grant No. OP1405 for the period October 1, 2013 to September 30, 2014 is closed and total eligible cost of \$436,922.11 were reimbursed to the City. The balance of \$13,077.89 (\$450,000 less \$436,922.11) will be reduced. Grant No. OP1503 has remaining balance of \$72,593.82 which is available for July 2015 to September 2015. Because of the overlap in the grant program year and the fiscal year, this amount is appropriated in both FY 2015 and FY 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

The General Fund will be reimbursed \$60,314.00 for related cost.
