ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the development of a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) at 6001 West Jefferson Boulevard.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Wesson - Price):

- INSTRUCT the Department of Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation (BOS), with the assistance and cooperation of the City Administrative Officer (CAO) and the Department of General Service (GSD), to review the feasibility of entering into negotiations with current property owners for the acquisition of property located at 6001 West Jefferson Boulevard, for the development of a MRF.
- 2. DIRECT the BOS, with the assistance and cooperation of the GSD, to report on the best manner to dispose of the remaining property located at 9940 West Jefferson Boulevard, including the feasibility of a land swap for property located at 6001 West Jefferson Boulevard.
- 3. DIRECT the BOS to report on the status of shared solid waste management between the City of Los Angeles and Culver City.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.
