SUMMARY

On September 14, 2015, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) notified the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) of an award of funds from the FY2015 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) for two projects: Advanced Marine Firefighter Training and Regional Ship Training Design in the amount of \$475,000. The performance period for the FY2015 PSGP is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2018.

The purpose of the PSGP funding is to support National Preparedness Goals to strengthen the Nation's critical infrastructure against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks through prevention, protection, mitigation, response, and recovery mission areas. Specifically, the grant award is for training and the design of a ship training platform to enhance the response skills of firefighting personnel to better serve the port region.

The PSGP award will enable the LAFD to deliver two projects totaling \$475,000. The first project is Advanced Marine Firefighter (AMFF) training in the amount of \$175,000 and the second is a contract for the design of a Regional Ship Training platform in the amount of \$300,000.

As the FY2015 PSGP is a cost-share reimbursement grant, the federal share of the grant is 75% with a 25% cost match provided by the LAFD. The PSGP requires that funds be reimbursed after

actual expenditures are made. As the LAFD incurs expenses from this program, the expenditures are forwarded to and reimbursed by FEMA on an ongoing basis in FY2015-16 through FY17-18. The total amount to deliver both projects is \$475,000. FEMA will fund \$356,250 on a reimbursement basis; the cost share amount of \$118,750 will be funded by the LAFD Special Training Fund 40J, Account 3840JB.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board:

- 1. Approve this report and forward to the Mayor and City Council for acceptance and authority to expend FY2015 Port Security Grant Program funding for Advanced Marine Firefighter Training and Regional Ship Training Design.
- 2. Request that the Mayor and City Council:
 - a. Authorize the Fire Chief to expend funds in the amount of \$475,000 from LAFD Special Training Fund 3840JB in accordance with the FY2015 PSGP award, from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), for the performance period of September 1, 2015, through to August 31, 2018, and any extension of the performance period granted by FEMA.
 - b. Authorize the LAFD to deposit reimbursement grant funds into Fund 335, Department 38, Account TBD.
 - c. Authorize the LAFD to transfer reimbursement grant funds from Fund 335, Department 38, Account TBD to LAFD Special Training Fund 40J, Account 3840JB.
 - d. Authorize the LAFD to prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the CAO, and authorize and instruct the Controller to implement the instructions.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no impact to the LAFD General Fund in FY2015-16. The LAFD will front-fund the expenditure up to \$475,000 associated with the FY2015 Port Security Grant Program through the LAFD Special Training Fund, Fund 40J, Account 3840JB. The FEMA will reimburse LAFD a total up to \$356,250 (75%); the required cost share up to \$118,750(25%) will be funded by the LAFD Special Training Fund 40J, Account 3840JB.
