
This is a letter in PROTEST against the proposed water rate restructure and increases for the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power.



I Protest to LADWP Water Rate Ordinance for the following reasons:

We do not need a rate increase for "infrastructure to provide reliable water supply" We already conserving water by changing our grassy lawns for desert, rocky cactus lawns, covering our pools so the water will not evaporate, filling our dishwashers to full before washing, taking shorter showers with a bucket on the floor of the shower to catch the cold water, sweeping instead of water hosing, watering our lawns twice per week instead of four times per week and it goes on and on.

As far as drinking water quality 90% of the population buys bottle water, use filters under the sink or in the refrigerator. Or have a water softener system all over the house to make the water softer and safer to drink. That cost each of us Lot's of money already, we are already making our water safe to drink. We don't need Federal and State to mandate how safe is our tap water and come up with a reason like the "state of the Art disinfection Facilities" to increase our rate. We are alive and healthy now. What about our tax monies can that be used for some of the projects?

It has been 100 yrs of no maintenance or upgrading the system, make you wander where did the monies that we pay all go? Our water bills keep going up. O yes! the BONUS the vacations paid to all the VIP,S the Pensions that all retired workers are living on (my friend tells me that he makes more money now that is retired than when he was working. Nothing lasts 100 yrs. It should have improved or maintained the system much earlier.

Maybe DWP should look into improving and controlling the administrative department to make better use of the Funds collected so it does not have to come out of our pockets.

Why did it take 36 or more hours in UCLA to stop the sink hole LEAK, and many others as well. That created millions of gallons of water waist !!

How can you expect to reduce the consumption of water if you have more people living in Los Angeles. O Yes, you also have more people paying for the water. Since 2009 (the last drought) new housing and business developments came up with huge landscaping and no restrictions were given to cut down on the water usage on their decorating grounds. Also Shopping and business Centers creating lots of water waist. If it is a fact that there is not water to spare it should not matter how many tiers you make us pay for higher cost. 
You are asking to send this letter before February 2016 meeting .That is almost one month before. That tells us that our opinion does not mean much. Your decisions probably are already made and you are
