On Friday, July 22, 2016, the Police Department (LAPD) responded to a robbery at a Metro PCS store located at 1006 East Vernon Avenue in the City of Los Angeles. Two suspects came into the store armed with handgun, and took money and cell phones as well as the personal property of individuals in the store. Over the following days, six additional robberies of cell phone stores occurred in other areas of the City, carried out by the same suspects. Detectives are continuing to investigate this matter, and believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the persons responsible for these crimes. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, MARCH 11, 2017.


