Due to the sensitive and complex nature of these investigations, which include counter-terrorism incidents and threats to public officials, the Cyber Unit needs the best tools available to work in a safe and expeditious manner. This equipment will afford the Cyber Unit the most flexibility and security while the unit works to combat the threat of terrorism throughout the City and County of Los Angeles.
