PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of six laptop computers, docking stations, and monitors for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Major Crimes Division.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of six laptop computers, docking stations, and monitors, valued at \$18,672.09, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD, Major Crimes Division; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated April 22, 2016, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of six laptop computers, docking stations, and monitors from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD, Major Crimes Division. The LAPD reports that the requested equipment will be utilized by the Major Crimes Division Cyber Intelligence Unit to conduct cyber intelligence investigations for the LAPD. Due to the sensitive and complex nature of these investigations, which include counter-terrorism incidents and threats to public officials, the Cyber Unit needs the best tools available to work in a safe and expeditious manner. This equipment will afford the Cyber Unit the most flexibility and security while the unit works to combat the threat of terrorism throughout the City and County of Los Angeles. Major Crimes Division has a restricted fund with the Los Angeles Police Foundation. The Los Angeles Police Foundation will use funds from this account to pay for the equipment. This equipment comes with a three-year warranty, and additional donations will be sought for any repairs outside the warranty period. At the meeting held on May 17, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of six laptop computers, docking stations, and monitors for the benefit of the LAPD, Major Crimes Division, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
