Having anytime access to these data through the iPad supports COMPSTAT's goal of reducing crime by allowing commanding officers to verify that field activities are accurately reflected in the statistics, supporting better decision-making and communication. In addition, the Department will be testing a variety of applications that might help in the field, such as tactical planning and mapping, and field reporting applications.
