DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). The iPads will enable command staff to have mobile COMPSTAT data access, which will assist them in reviewing crime statistics while in the field. The availability of this data will enable commanding officers to make more timely and accurate decisions on intelligence, tactics, deployment and follow-up. The use of these tablets will also serve as a means of "going green" since commanding officers will not have to print and carry large binders of data on a weekly basis. Application Development and Support Division has a restricted fund account with the Los Angeles Police Foundation. Funds from this account are to be used specifically for the purchase of these iPads.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.



COMPSTAT provides statistics for various crimes and locations which are compared weekly, monthly, and annually for individual Part I crimes, property crimes, and violent crimes. COMPSTAT also reflects risk management information such as uses of force, pursuits, complaints, arrests, and field interviews. The iPads will enable command staff to have mobile COMPSTAT data access, which will greatly assist them in reviewing crime statistics while in the field. These tablets are also a means of "going green," as commanding officers will avoid having to print and carry large binders of data on a weekly basis.

COMPSTAT provides statistics for various crimes and locations, which are compared weekly, monthly, and annually for individual Part I crimes, property crimes, and violent crimes. COMPSTAT also reflects risk management information such as uses of force, pursuits, complaints, arrests, and field interviews. Having anytime access to these data through the iPad supports COMPSTAT's goal of reducing crime by allowing commanding officers to verify that field activities are accurately reflected in the statistics, supporting better decision-making and communication. In addition, the Department will be testing a variety of applications that might help in the field, such as tactical planning and mapping, and field reporting applications.
