DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of Southeast Area and will allow for the continuation of Southeast's DART program in partnership with Project PeaceMakers, Inc. The Los Angeles Police Department (Department) receives over 40,000 domestic violence calls a year. During peak hours for domestic violence calls, Southeast Area deploys DART cars ideally consisting of one uniformed officer and two citizen advocates in a plain car and a chase unit consisting of two uniformed officers in a black and white patrol car. The deployment of a DART unit aims to provide early intervention services that assist domestic violence victims in obtaining aid and resources. The training DART officers receive provides them with specialized knowledge that enables them to focus on the uniqueness of domestic violence investigations, which results in more appropriate methods of counseling and more thorough and complete investigative reports. This program has also allowed for better allocation of resources by freeing up units to handle non-domestic violence calls for service.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.
