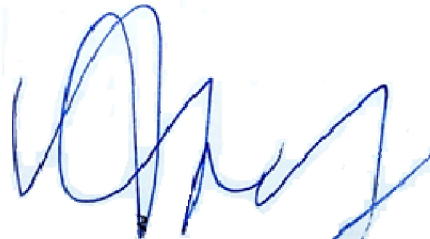

DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of Rampart Area and the community it serves. The DART program is a collaborative effort between the Department and Children's Institute, Incorporated (CII), a non-profit organization specializing in the treatment and prevention of child abuse and neglect. The program will provide victims of domestic violence with immediate crisis intervention and emergency assistance at the onset of the abusive event and continuing throughout the investigative and judicial process. This program will ultimately reduce the likelihood of future incidents, injury, or the escalation and severity of the abuse, while helping to break the cycle of violence and create safe and secure neighborhoods. The perception of the Department by domestic violence victims will be improved by building trust and relationships between the Department and the community. The collaboration with DART will also allow Rampart Area officers and detectives to focus their efforts on apprehending and prosecuting the batterers. The Los Angeles Police Foundation will provide vendor direct funding to support Rampart Area's DART program.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.
