#### DISCUSSION

The donation is for the benefit of Topanga Area and the community it serves. The remote video traffic monitoring system includes a license-plate reader, camera, and electric message board that can be controlled remotely. This equipment will enhance public safety and assist with policing of the Westfield Topanga Mall, the largest mall in the western States. There is a two-year warranty for the camera and a five-year warranty for the message board. Motor Transport Division has added the equipment to its fleet and will provide registration fees. Police Surveillance Specialist Shawn Khacherian, Technology Investigation Division, advised that the camera will have no compatibility issues with current Department capabilities. Topanga Area has a restricted fund account with the Los Angeles Police Foundation (Foundation). The Foundation will use funds from this account to pay for the equipment.

It should be noted that the original amount of the donation was \$58,000.00, with \$24,299.69 being earmarked for the purchase of smartphones that would allow Topanga Area Senior Lead Officers to conduct social media networking. In light of Topanga Area receiving body-worn cameras and smartphones in October 2016, this portion of the donation will be held in abeyance until it can be determined if these phones can be programmed for internet access or if they must be kept strictly dedicated to the body-worn camera system. If the phones that came with the body-worn cameras can have a dual use, the \$24,299.69 will either be returned to the donor or

dedicated to another use. Separate correspondence will follow in the event the money can be put to another use.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.
