RECOMMENDED ACTION

DISCUSSION

This donation is for the benefit of Metropolitan Division's Mounted Platoon. The Mounted Platoon's Equestrian Arena is in need of repair and painting. The Arena has not been painted in over seven years, and, due to prolonged exposure to outside elements, many of the Arena's beams have large rust spots that could compromise the integrity of the structure if left untreated. The Department of General Services (GSD) provided an estimate for the necessary painting and repairs that was considerably more expensive than the contractor selected to perform the work. Additionally, GSD indicated that budget constraints would mean having to wait several years for the Equestrian Arena to be painted and repaired. Due to the current state of the Arena, further delay could cause irreparable damage and a significantly greater cost to repair. Lieutenant Orlando Chandler, Facilities Management Division, has reviewed and approved the specifics of the work to be completed, and the Los Angeles Police Mounted Foundation will pay the contractor directly.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department (Department) patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.
