In a report to the Board dated March 3, 2016, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of registration fees from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD. The LAPD reports that the donation will give LAPD personnel the opportunity to attend training hosted by the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates. The symposium, was held on March 10, 2016, explored and addressed issues of domestic violence, risk management, physical and mental abuse, post-traumatic stress syndrome, building self-confidence and resilience, and conducting thorough field investigations. At the meeting held on December 6, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of registration fees for the benefit of the LAPD, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
