PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of a 12-passenger van for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Hollywood Area.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of a 12-passenger van, valued at \$19,700, from the Hollywood Police Activities League, for the benefit of the LAPD, Hollywood Area; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board dated February 3, 2017, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of a 12-passenger van for the benefit of the LAPD, Hollywood Area. The LAPD reports that the van will be used to transport Hollywood Area Police Activities League and Cadet youth to and from activities. Director of Police Transportation George Yamanaka, Motor Transport Division (MTD), has advised that MTD will be able to maintain the vehicle and accept it into Hollywood Area's fleet. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any LAPD patents. At the meeting held on February 21, 2017, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of a 12-passenger van for the benefit of the LAPD, Hollywood Area, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
