PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of registration fees for Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) employees to attend the Los Angeles Women Police Officers and Associates (LAWPOA) 2017 Professional Training and Development Symposium for the benefit of the LAPD.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of registration fees for LAPD employees to attend the LAWPOA 2017 Professional Training and Development Symposium, valued at \$35,000, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, for the benefit of the LAPD; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

**SUMMARY**

In a report to the Board dated March 24, 2017, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of registration fees for LAPD employees to attend the LAWPOA 2017 Professional Training and Development Symposium from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD. The LAPD reports that the donation will give LAPD personnel the opportunity to attend training hosted by LAWPOA. The symposium, which will be held on March 30, 2017, will explore and address issues of home grown terrorism, lessons learned following a terrorist attack, the impact on law enforcement in those states following the legalization of marijuana, overcoming adversity and tragedy, and an in-depth presentation on overcoming hurdles and setting goals for a successful career. At the meeting held on May 2, 2017, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of registration fees for LAPD employees to attend the LAPOA 2017 Professional Training and Development Symposium for the benefit of the LAPD, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
