PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of building materials and labor for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Devonshire Area.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of building materials and labor, valued at \$22,746, from the Toll Brothers Inc., for the benefit of the LAPD, Devonshire Area; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board dated December 28, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of building materials and labor from the Toll Brothers Inc. for the benefit of the LAPD, Devonshire Area. The LAPD reports that the donation is in support of the costs of building a wooden framed, shaded trellis approximately 15' x 19' over the BBQ area for LAPD, Devonshire Area. Thom Brennan, Commanding Officer, Facilities Management Division, has approved the donation for use by LAPD, Devonshire Area. There are no continuing costs associated with the acceptance of this donation. At the meeting held on December 6, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered this matter. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of building materials and labor for the benefit of the LAPD, Devonshire Area, as recommended by the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
