**DISCUSSION**

The donation is for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (Department), and will be used to provide ongoing training to sworn members of the Department in an effort to enhance community relationships and improve the daily interactions between officers and the City's diverse communities. Personnel will receive training in recognizing and dealing with implicit bias as it relates to community policing, as well as issues relevant to 21<sup>st</sup> Century Policing. The four-hour course will be incorporated into the Police Sciences and Leadership program, and approximately 30 to 40 officers will be trained every Deployment Period for a total of 390 to 520 officers annually.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.
