- ACCEPT a monetary donation in the amount of \$250,000 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the Harvard Park Community Safety Partnership Program, for the benefit of 77th Street Area and the community it serves; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.
- 2. APPROPRIATE \$235,000 to the Police Department Trust Fund No. 885/70P807, Department No. 70 for Harvard Park Community Safety Partnership Program; and REIMBURSE to Fund No. 100, Department No. 70 the following:
 - a. Account No. 1012- Salaries Sworn \$90,000
 - b. Account No. 1092-Overtime Sworn \$145,000

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

In a report to the BOPC dated May 1, 2019 (attached to the Council file), the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) is requesting authority to accept a donation in the amount of \$250,000 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the Harvard Park Community Safety Partnership (CSP) Program, for the benefit of 77th Street Area and the community it serves. The CSP program consists of four inter-related units: community engagement, school safe passage, critical enforcement, and youth programs. The CSP aims to impact four outcomes: reduce violence, improve the community's perception of public safety, improve relationships between law enforcement and the community, and improve youth educational opportunities. On May 21, 2019, the BOPC approved the LAPD's request. Subsequently, on August 14, 2019, the Committee considered this matter and after having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend authorizing the LAPD to accept this donation. Also, the Committee moved to recommend the appropriation of \$235,000 of the donation to reimburse the LAPD. This matter is now submitted to the Council for its consideration.
