The donation was received on August 27, 2017, and will benefit the Metropolitan Division Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team. These specific explosive transport magazines are required by Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) regulations to safely transport related charges and detonators, which are needed during explosive breaching operations (i.e. Hostage Rescue Tactics).

The addition of these explosive transport magazines will make explosive charges readily available in all supervisory police vehicles assigned to SWAT. *Currently, only the responding Lieutenant has this capability*. Because of the limited availability/inventory currently available there are logistical delays when deployment and immediate accessibility are needed. With the additional inventory and increased availability, we will have taken the appropriate steps to eliminate and/or reduce these tactical delays when a breaching deployment is imminent.

The addition of these boxes to additional personnel does not change any existing policy and procedure in its use or the approval process required for its deployment

The build specifications provided to McDaniel. Inc. were reviewed by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Bomb Squad and approved for fabrication and were found to be consistent with ATF guidelines (ATF P 5400.7).
