**DISCUSSION**

This donation is for the benefit of the Metropolitan Division Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team. Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) regulations require these specific magazines to safely transport charges and detonators needed during explosive breaching operations. The donation of these items will allow all SWAT supervisory vehicles to transport explosive charges, reducing tactical and logistical delays when deployment and immediate accessibility are needed. The Los Angeles Police Department (Department) Bomb Squad reviewed and approved the items and found them to be consistent with ATF guidelines.

No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Department.

The donation was received on August 27, 2017, and will benefit the Metropolitan Division Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team. These specific explosive transport magazines are required by Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) regulations to safely transport related charges and detonators, which are needed during explosive breaching operations (i.e. Hostage Rescue Tactics).

The addition of these explosive transport magazines will make explosive charges readily available in all supervisory police vehicles assigned to SWAT. *Currently, only the responding Lieutenant has this capability.* Because of the limited availability/inventory currently available there are logistical delays when deployment and immediate accessibility are needed. With the additional inventory and increased availability, we will have taken the appropriate steps to eliminate and/or reduce these tactical delays when a breaching deployment is imminent.

The addition of these boxes to additional personnel does not change any existing policy and procedure in its use or the approval process required for its deployment

The build specifications provided to McDaniel, Inc. were reviewed by the Los Angeles Police Department's (LAPD) Bomb Squad and approved for fabrication and were found to be consistent with ATF guidelines (ATF P 5400.7).

**SPECIFICATIONS:**

- 1) Box and lid to be .125" min. carbon steel.
- 2) All finished dimensions are to be + or - .065".
- 3) Lids to have 1" overhang on sides & 4.25" in front & flush in back as per drawing.
- 4) Inside top edge of both compartments to be bent inward @ 90 degrees x .750".
- 5) The lid to rise .500" upward when lid is locked with padlock.
- 6) The back of the lid to be flush with back of box with 2" welded continues hinge (3/16" pin & 1" knuckle length).
- 7) The locking cans are to be 4x4 (enclosed on 5 sides) w/opening toward the side outside & welded to box.
- 8) The locking pin to be .375" thick x 1" flat bar welded to lid & hole to accommodate a .375" dia. shackle for pad lock.
- 9) Weld to inside of lid 4 each bolts as per drawing.
- 10) Box and lids to be square.
- 11) This completed magazine meets BATF Type 3 spec's and DOT IME 22 spec's.

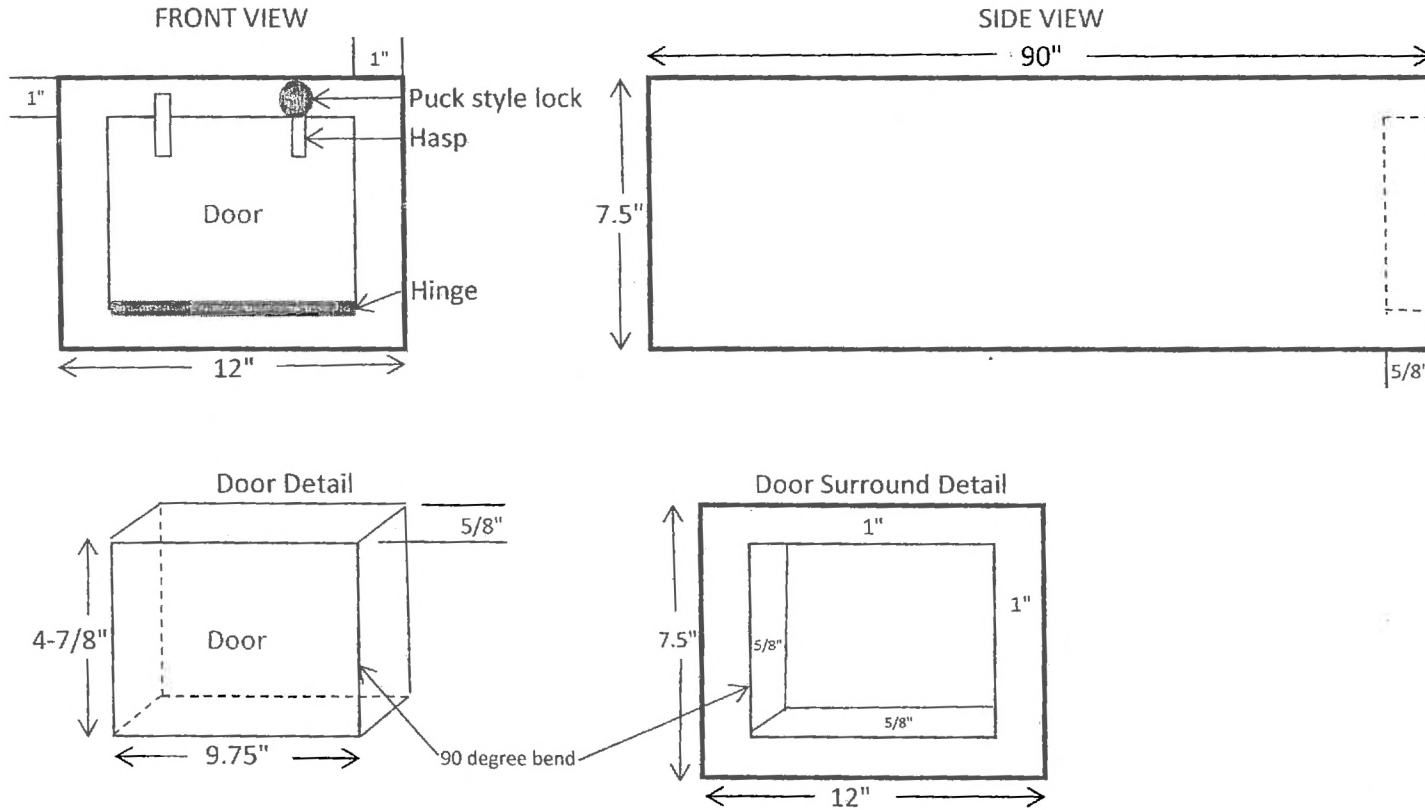
