PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of small Unmanned Aerial Systems (sUAS) for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. ACCEPT the donation of sUAS from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, valued at \$31,528.36, to be used by the Special Weapons and Tactics Team, for the benefit of the LAPD, Metropolitan Division; and, THANK the donor for this generous donation.
- 2. INSTRUCT the LAPD that any modifications to the sUAS Deployment Policy needs to be presented to the Board of Police Commissioners, the Public Safety Committee and the City Council.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At a special meeting held on February 7, 2018, the Public Safety Committee considered a Board of Police Commissioners report regarding a donation of sUAS for the benefit of the LAPD. Deputy Chief Girmala provided the Committee information pertaining to the sUAS Deployment Policy and the uses for the sUAS. After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the donation as amended to include that any modifications to the policy would need to be presented to the Board of Police Commissioners, the Public Safety Committee and the City Council. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
