Adopted March 23, 2016

The lack of sufficient funding for permanent supportive housing and homeless services in the City and County of Los Angeles is the most significant obstacle to ending homelessness. It is the official position of the San Fernando & Santa Clarita Valley Homeless Coalition that the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, or both should place an initiative on the November ballot that creates a dedicated revenue stream to build the housing and provide the services we need to effectively end homelessness in the region.
