Committee instructions

- Options for strengthening the Office of Public Accountability / Ratepayer Advocate (OPA), outlined in the April 5, 2016 report
- OPA to provide options for making the Office more effective and efficient
- Analysis of option for instituting an ex-officio role for the Ratepayer
 Advocate (RPA, Executive Director of the OPA)

Summary: Strengthening the OPA

Access to information

- History of challenges in receiving timely information, but much more responsive with current DWP General Manager.
- Administrative Code Modifications
 - Clarify Charter OPA information access language specifically to include "books and records" access
 - CLA and CAO have a concern with this approach
 - o Get DWP Board and GM input on information access clarification

Office resources and hiring

- OPA is authorized for 7 positions, but has filled only 4, limited by minimum budget and authority to fill vacancies with exempt positions
- Administrative Code Modifications
 - Increase OPA minimum budget from 0.025% to 0.050% of DWP gross revenues via change to Administrative Code Section 23.144(d)(5) or via change to Charter Section 683. No impact on General Fund.
- Flexible staffing plan
 - Instruct CAO to assist OPA in flexible staffing plan and a request for exempt positions

Summary (con't.)

- Adoption of a reappointment process for RPA
 - Charter and Administrative Code is silent on number terms for RPA and do not provide a process for reappointment
 - Instruct the CAO and CLA ot work with City Attorney to determine best method for reappointment and to draft an ordinance establishing the necessary procedures
- Ex-Officio Role for RPA
 - Add a seat to the DWP Board for RPA in an Ex-Officio role
 - o Offices do not recommend because of RPA's role as advisor to Board, but agree the only potential benefit is increased access to information
 - If Council wishes to pursue this option, a Charter amendment is likely avenue
