
I am a quadriplegic using an electric wheelchair and work full time as an engineer at California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), Los Angeles District. I live with and depend on my two caregivers for my daily personal needs.

Two years ago I decided to build a separate unit for my caregivers in my backyard. After receiving full permits (Permit# [12010-30000-02238](#)) from the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) for building a second unit on my property, I started the construction of my project in September 2015. I have followed all the City's rules and regulations and have passed all necessary inspections so far. Up to this stage, I have also spent more than \$170,000 on the construction. My project is almost completed pending final inspection.

On April 18, 2016, the City Inspector, Robert Vorhis, informed me that further inspections have been suspended on my property due to a court order. This is totally unfair and is creating big financial loss and undue hardship for me not to be able to get the final inspection on my project.
