Dear Transportation Committee:

As a concerned Angelino, I respectfully urge you to prioritize investing Measure M local return dollars to fund projects that will improve walking and biking routes and fund safe routes to schools programs in the city of Los Angeles.

I supported Measure M in November specifically because it would help fund long-overlooked street and sidewalk repairs throughout LA County. Nearly 80% of U.S. adults and 75% of adolescents do not currently get the recommended amount of physical activity each week. Studies show that more and better quality sidewalks are associated with higher rates of walking and more adults meeting their daily physical activity recommendations.

I respectfully urge you to take this opportunity to prioritize investing in projects that enhance Angelinos ability to live a safe and physically active lifestyle.







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
